

The Price Indices for November 2017

Consumer Price Indices (CPI)

The CPI in November 2017 (2011=100) increased 0.24% from the preceding month. Prices of fruits, tobacco and betel nuts, and fuels and lubricants rose 7.20%, 6.92%, and 4.17%, respectively. On the other hand, the price of garments fell 2.56%. The general CPI excluding fruits, vegetables and energy (core CPI) decreased 0.09%.

The annual change of CPI in November 2017, compared with the same month of 2016, increased 0.35%. Prices of tobacco and betel nuts, fuels and lubricants, water, electricity and gas supply, and fish and seafood rose 24.46%, 13.49%, 4.82%, and 4.72%, respectively. Nonetheless, prices of vegetables, eggs and fruits fell 21.69%, 12.05%, and 11.94%, respectively. The core CPI increased 1.30%.


For the first eleven months of 2017, the CPI increased 0.57% over the same period of previous year. The price of services rose 1.00%, while that of commodity fell 0.01%. The core CPI increased 0.99%.

Wholesale Price Indices (WPI)

The WPI in November 2017 increased 0.48% from the preceding month. Prices of crude petroleum and natural gas, petroleum and coal products, and farm products increased 7.95%, 3.71%, and 2.65%, respectively.

The annual change of WPI in November 2017, compared with the same month of 2016, increased 1.57%. Prices of quarrying and mineral products, petroleum and coal products, basic metal, and chemical materials rose 22.15%, 15.60%, 11.66%, and 8.66%, respectively. However, the price of farm products decreased 22.59%. The WPI for domestic sales excluding imports increased 3.50%, imports price index also rose 2.53%, but export price index decreased 0.79%.

For the first eleven months of 2017, the WPI increased 0.95% over the same period of previous year.
