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
The Price Indices for June 2008


Consumer Price Indices (CPI)

The CPI in June 2008 was 106.18 (2006=100), rising 1.83% from previous month. Due primarily to both Vegetables and Fruits prices went up 19.25% and 11.65% separately in rainy season, Water, Electricity & Gas Supply prices moved up 10.50% for Taiwan Power Company applied the summer rate, and Fuels & Lubricants up 9.27% to reflect increasing costs. However, Prices of Garments declined 4.29%. The General Index excluding Fruits, Vegetables, Fish, Shellfish and Energy, i.e. core CPI, increased 0.42%.

The annual change rate for CPI in June 2008, compared with the same month of previous year, was 4.97%. Prices of Food increased 11.89%, of which Edible Oil up 47.00%, Fruits up 27.14%, Meat up 21.97%, Dairy Products up 14.68%, Fish & Shellfish up 14.03%, Cereals & Cereal Products up 12.73%, and Food Away from Home advanced 10.17%, whereas Vegetables decreased 5.10%. Transportation & Communication prices rose 6.40%, due mainly to prices of Fuels & Lubricants up 23.23%, while parts of communication and telecommunication fees went down. Furthermore, prices of Gas Supply rose 17.46%.

For the first half-year of 2008, the CPI rose by 3.89% over the same period of previous year, as prices of Commodity and Service moved up 5.76% and 2.16% individually. The core CPI up 3.07%.






Wholesale Price Indices (WPI)

The WPI in June 2008 was 117.18 (2006=100), rising 1.88% from previous month, due primarily to prices of Petroleum & Coal Products moved up 10.80%, Crude Petroleum & Natural Gas went up 6.54%, and Chemical Material increased 5.25%, where Domestic Sales Excluding Imports, Imports and Exports prices increased 3.47%, 1.47% and 0.76% respectively.

The annual change rate for WPI in June 2008 jumping to 9.86%, due mainly to prices of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas, Petroleum & Coal Products, Basic Metal and Chemical Material advanced 71.40%, 44.12%, 19.05% and 15.06% separately, whereas Taiwan Dollar to U.S. Dollar appreciated 8.52%. Domestic Sales Excluding Imports prices up 14.35%, Imports prices up 16.01%, while Exports prices decreased 0.71%.

For the first half-year of 2008, the WPI jumped 8.35% compared with the same period of previous year, of which the Import Price Index rose 14.00%, while Export Price Index down 0.95%.
