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
The Price Indices for July 2008

Consumer Price Indices (CPI)

The CPI in July 2008 was 106.88 (2006=100), rising 0.66% from previous month. Due primarily to Crude Oil prices were still high this month. Prices of Fuels & Lubricants, airline fares, and package tours' fee went up. Water, Electricity & Gas Supply prices moved up 3.96%. Besides, Vegetables prices jumped 8.12% due to the damage of typhoon, while prices of Fruits and Garments declined 6.39% and 5.98% respectively. The General Index excluding Fruits, Vegetables, Fish, Shellfish and Energy, i.e. core CPI, increased 0.33%.

The annual change rate for CPI in July 2008, compared with the same month of previous year, was 5.92%, the record high from Oct. 1994. Prices of Food increased 13.61%, of which Edible Oil up 42.02%, Fruits up 25.52%, Meat up 24.76%, Fish & Shellfish up 15.82%, Cereals & Cereal Products up 13.48%, Dairy Products up 13.32%, Vegetables up 10.16%, and Food Away from Home advanced 9.01%. Transportation & Communication prices rose 6.80%, due mainly to prices of Fuels & Lubricants up 23.26%, however, Public Transportation fare and telecommunication fees went down. The core CPI up 4.06%.

For the first seven months of 2008, the CPI rose by 4.18% over the same period of previous year, as prices of Commodity and Service moved up 6.30% and 2.27% individually. The core CPI up 3.21%.




Wholesale Price Indices (WPI)

The WPI in July 2008 was 119.05 (2006=100), rising 1.62% from previous month, due primarily to prices of Petroleum & Coal Products moved up 5.77%, Chemical Material increased 3.60%, and Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas went up 3.54%, where Domestic Sales Excluding Imports, Imports and Exports prices increased 2.04%, 1.94% and 0.84% respectively.

The annual change rate for WPI in July 2008 jumping to 11.49%, due mainly to prices of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas rose 68.57%, Petroleum & Coal Products moved up 46.15%, Basic Metal and Chemical Material advanced 23.78% and 21.60% separately, whereas Taiwan Dollar to U.S. Dollar appreciated 7.92%. Domestic Sales Excluding Imports prices went up 16.83%, Imports and Exports prices up 17.23% and 0.63% individually.

For the first seven months of 2008, the WPI jumped 8.81% compared with the same period of previous year, of which the Import Price Index rose 14.48%, while Export Price Index down 0.76%.
