

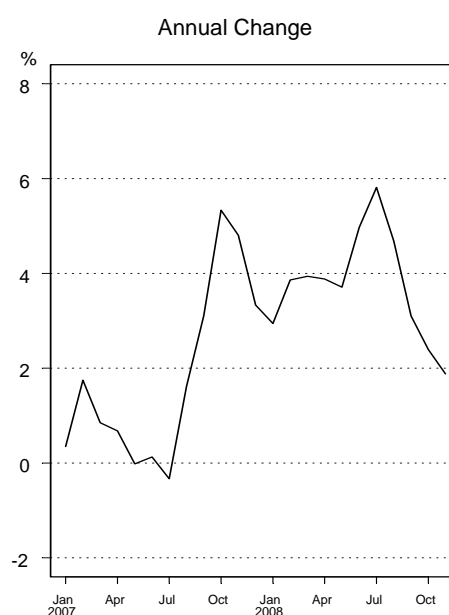
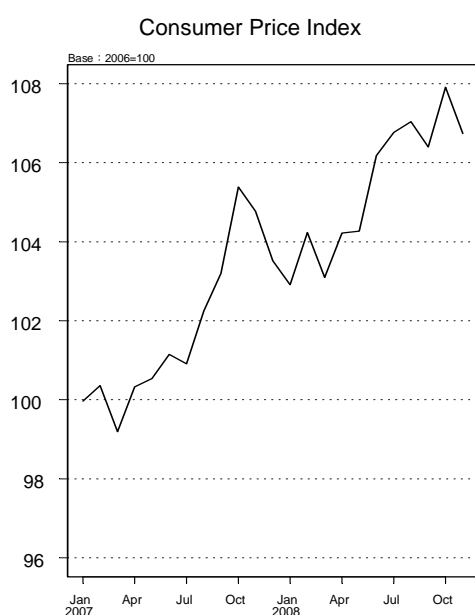
The Price Indices for November 2008

Consumer Price Indices (CPI)

The CPI in November 2008 was 106.74 (2006=100), falling 1.08% from previous month. Due to the substantially decrease of international prices of Crude Oil and Cereal, the price of Fuels & Lubricants went down 17.03%, Vegetables price declined 7.67% and Water, Electricity & Gas Supply fee decreased 1.86%. The General Index excluding Fruits, Vegetables, Fish, Shellfish and Energy, i.e. core CPI, moved down 0.22%.

The annual change rate for CPI in November 2008, compared with the same month of previous year, was 1.88%. Prices of Food moved up 6.94%, where Fish & Shellfish went up 13.3%, Meat up 10.25%, Vegetables up 15.12%, and Fruits moved up 3.95%. Housing prices rose 1.59%, due mainly to prices of Water, Electricity & Gas Supply went up 6.46%. Transportation & Communication prices fell 5.53%, due primarily to prices of Fuels & Lubricants declined greatly 24.21%. The core CPI advanced 2.40%.

For the first eleven months of 2008, the CPI increased by 3.73% over the same period of previous year, as prices of Commodity and Service moved up 5.37% and 2.31% individually. The core CPI up 3.16%.

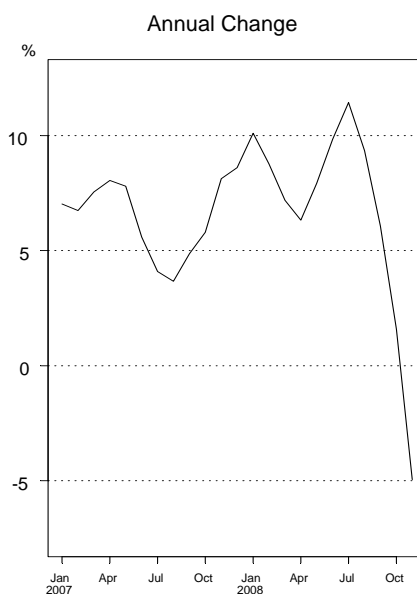
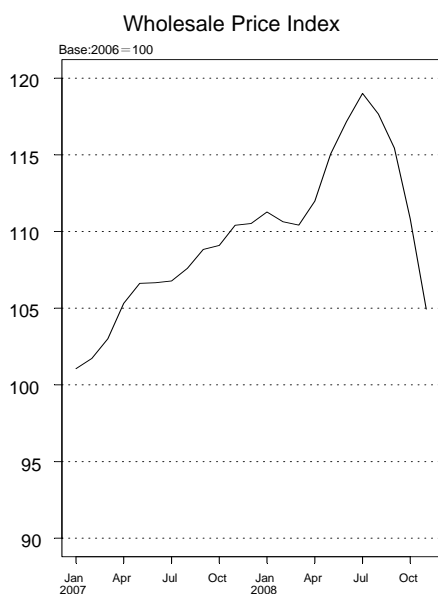


Wholesale Price Indices (WPI)

The WPI in November 2008 was 104.94 (2006=100), decreasing 5.31% from previous month, due primarily to prices of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas moved down 25.35%, Petroleum & Coal Products declined 19.33%, Chemical Material and Basic Metal went down 15.62% and 11.08% individually. Domestic Sales Excluding Imports, Imports and Exports prices declined 6.99%, 5.52% and 3.48% separately.

The annual change rate for WPI in November 2008 decreasing 4.95%, due mainly to prices of Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas went down 37.26%, Chemical Material, Petroleum & Coal Products and Basic Metal moved down 19.75%, 16.16% and 10.99% respectively. Domestic Sales Excluding Imports prices fell 2.81% and Imports and Exports prices went down 6.52% and 5.37% individually.

For the first eleven months of 2008, the WPI advanced 6.63% compared with the same period of previous year, of which the Import Price Index rose 10.82%, while Export Price Index fell 1.41%.
